This is an extract from 2 much larger survey reports covering eight areas in North Somerset:

North Somerset Levels Winter Bird Survey 2023-24

North Somerset Levels Breeding Bird Survey Spring 2024

The Kingston Seymour survey route is shown below followed by the details of the four surveys and the number of birds recorded.

Each survey walk takes about three hours, all birds that are seen or heard are counted and it is recorded whether the birds observed are nearby (up to 25 metres away) or further off.

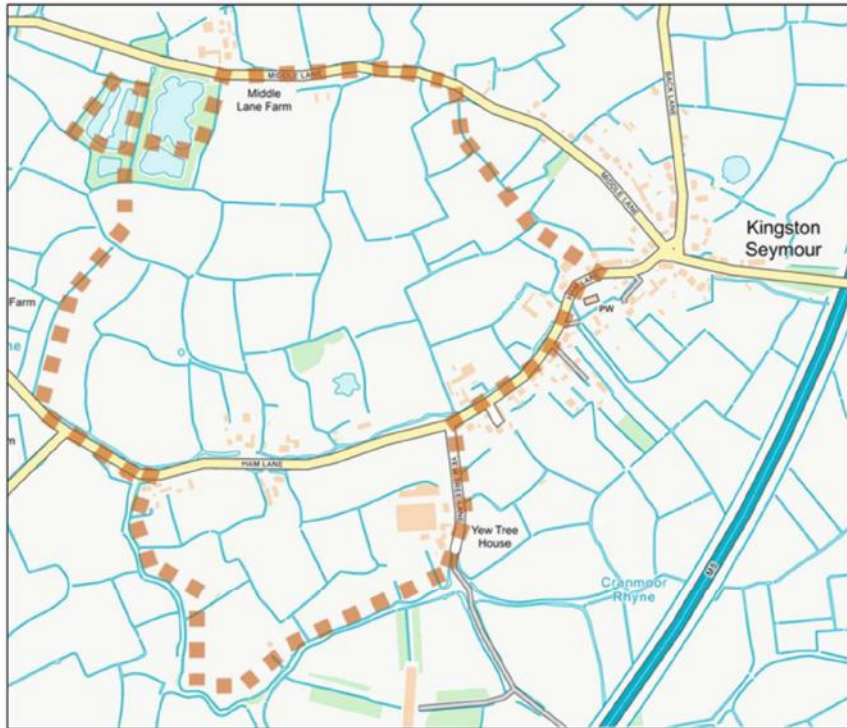
589 birds were counted during the two spring surveys across 39 species.

1489 birds were counted during the two winter surveys across 47 species.

All the surveys are carried out in the morning so bird species that are active late in the evening and at night are unlikely to be observed. Barn Owls and Tawney Owls are known to be resident in the area.
